### HOW TO APPLY

All undergraduate applicants must submit a **completed online application** via the **SUNY** or **Common Application**, as well as:

- **Official high school and college (if applicable) transcripts**
- **Minimum 2.5 out of 4.0 GPA required**
- **Proof of English proficiency (may include one year of study at US college)**

Students should **apply by November 1 for Spring** semester admission, or by **May 1 for Fall**.

### Destination Oswego Scholarship

These awards are available to first-year and transfer non-New York state residents and international students, who are not otherwise eligible for New York state tuition, and require full-time study. All students at Seattle area colleges who are admitted to Oswego will receive the **\$9,000** annual award. Requires on-campus housing and full-time status.

### Transfer Achievement/Merit Scholarships

Transfer students entering with 24 or more credits and a GPA of 3.30 or higher are eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship which is renewable for up to three years with a 3.0 or higher GPA at SUNY Oswego. Complete an application for admission to be considered; no scholarship forms are required.

## LOCATION

SUNY Oswego is located on a **280-hectares campus** with nearly 2 km of scenic Lake Ontario shoreline. The small city of Oswego is peaceful and friendly, with nearly 20,000 residents and is within 4-6 hours driving distance from New York City, Philadelphia, Boston, Montreal, and Toronto.

Regular bus service is free for students on campus and within the city of Oswego. A discounted bus service into the neighboring city of Syracuse is also available, which offers connections throughout North America.
