Destination Oswego Scholarship

These awards are available to first-year and transfer non-New York state residents and international students, who are not otherwise eligible for New York state tuition, and require full-time study. All students at Seattle area colleges who are admitted to Oswego will receive the \$9,000 annual award. Requires on-campus housing and full-time status.

Transfer Achievement/Merit Scholarships

Transfer students entering with 24 or more credits and a GPA of 3.30 or higher are eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship which is renewable for up to three years with a 3.0 or higher GPA at SUNY Oswego. LOCATION

SUNY Oswego is located on a 280-hectares campus with nearly 2 km of scenic Lake Ontario shoreline. The small city of Oswego is peaceful and friendly, with nearly 20,000 residents and is within 4-6 hours driving distance from New York City, Philadelphia, Boston, Montreal, and Toronto.
