

Where You Study Matters





Current Research:

Dr. Bai's interests focus on the general topics of resilient infrastructure and sustainable construction materials, including development of probabilistic models and fragility curves, damage assessment and loss estimation, performance evaluation and retrofit of structures, and structural behavior of high performance concrete and fiber-reinforced concrete. His previous research achievements in the area of development of fragility curves for several types of buildings and a probabilistic framework for structural damage assessment have been successfully implemented into MAEViz, a regional seismic loss estimation tool developed by the Mid-America Earthquake (MAE) Center.






