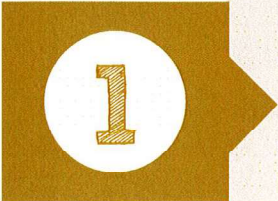




International Students: Apply to FIU today!

Future Panthers can apply as early as July 1 each year. Admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis until May 1 each year.

Apply for admission at go.fiu.edu/fiuapply and submit the following:



- Non-refundable \$30 application fee
- Official transcripts sent electronically or mailed in a sealed envelope
- Official scores for the SAT (code: **5206**) or ACT (code: **0776**) sent directly from collegeboard.org or actstudent.org
- Official English proficiency scores sent directly from testing agency
TOEFL: 80iBT 550 Paper-based IELTS: 6.5
- All documents must be presented in English or with an official English translation
