ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

FRESHMAN

GPA—Equivalent of a minimum 3.0 high school GPA on 4.0 scale

Language—4 years of English or your native language

Mathematics—3 years

Science—3 years (including at least two years of courses that emphasize elements of biology, chemistry, or physics)

Social Studies—2 years

While SAT or ACT scores are not required for admission, students who achieve either of the two minimum test scores below are automatically considered to have met the 3.0 GPA requirement:

- 1200 SAT combined score (Evidence-based Reading and Writing score + Math score)
- 25 ACT composite score

TRANSFER

Minimum GPA of 2.25 on a 4.00 scale in all transferrable courses.

If a student has earned an Associate's degree the minimum GPA requirement is 2.00.

*The transfer GPA requirement for Spring 2021 admission is 2.75 for engineering applicants and 2.30 for all other majors.

CREDIT BY EXAM

We participate in A Levels, GAC, IB, AP, and CLEP. If you have advanced knowledge in one of your core subjects, consider credit by exam. More information is available at admissions.iastate.edu/cbe.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT (ONLY ONE IS REQUIRED)

- **TOEFL:** Internet-based (IBT) score of 71 with a 17 or above on the Speaking and Writing
- **IELTS:** Overall band score of 6.0 with no subscore below 5.5
- **PTE:** Score of 48
- **SAT:** Evidence-based Writing and Reading (EWR) score of 460
- **ACT:** English subscore of 19
- **Duolingo English Test (DET):** 100 overall score to the English proficiency requirement list; after PTE and before SAT.

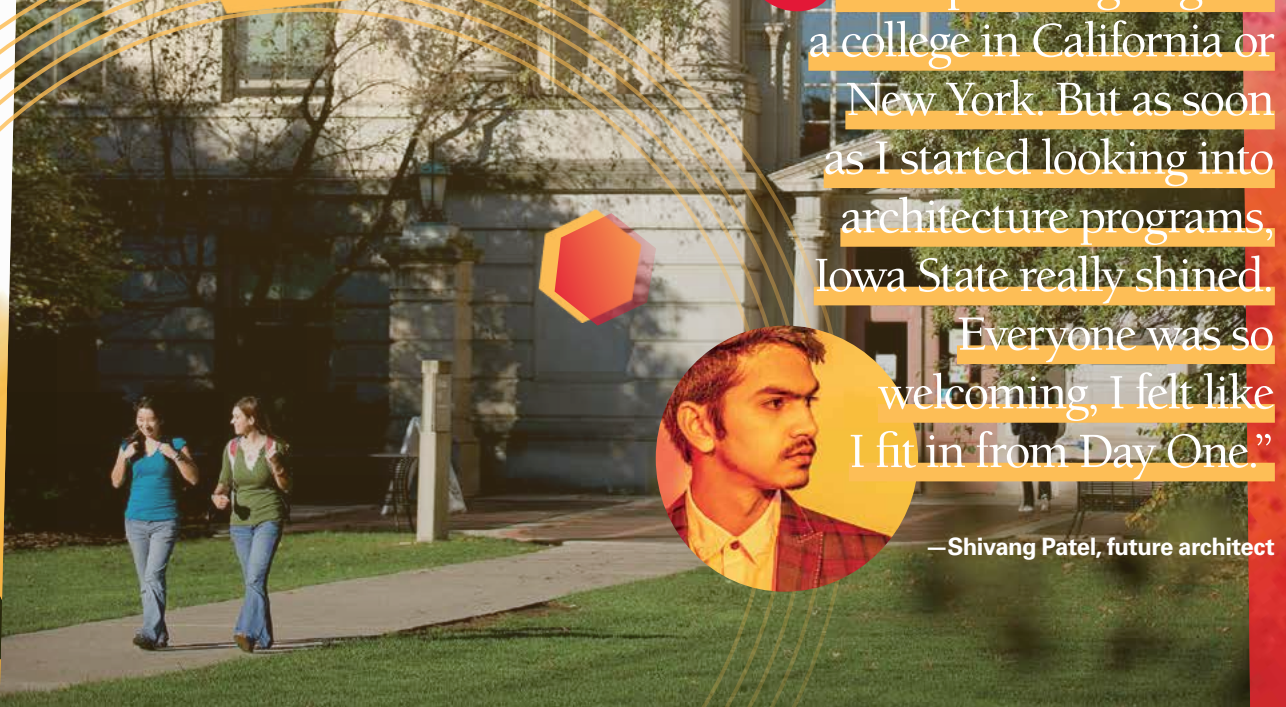
