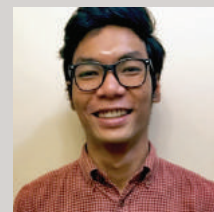

# Transfer Student Application Checklist

To be accepted to IUPUI as a transfer student, you must complete the steps listed below.

**MEET ADMISSION STANDARDS**

We look to see that you have maintained a “C” grade average and have an overall 2.0 GPA or better in college level courses.

**SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION**

Submit the **nonrefundable \$65 application fee** to complete the online application at [iapply.iupui.edu](http://iapply.iupui.edu).

**SEND OFFICIAL, ORIGINAL ACADEMIC RECORDS**

You must send your official, original records to start the admission process. Your records should be sent directly from your institution to the address listed below.

**SUBMIT SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS VIA ATLAS**

You must submit your supporting documents at [atlas.iu.edu](http://atlas.iu.edu). Atlas is our online portal for international students.

**Proof of English Proficiency**

You can use your Freshman English Composition Course with a “C” grade or higher to prove proficiency. All of our English proficiency requirements can be found at [iapply.iupui.edu/admissions](http://iapply.iupui.edu/admissions).

**Financial Documentation for Visa Purposes**

You must submit a financial support agreement form and a recent bank statement. More information can be found at [iapply.iupui.edu](http://iapply.iupui.edu).

**TRANSFER CREDIT**

We require final **official** transcripts to perform a transfer credit evaluation. Documents must be sent to the Office of International Affairs address listed above. Visit [iapply.iupui.edu/admissions](http://iapply.iupui.edu/admissions) to view our course catalog and see how your classes could transfer.

## \$10,000 TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

You will be automatically considered for the transfer scholarship when you apply for admission.

You may be eligible if you:

- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Have completed at least 12 semester credits or equivalent.
