New York Tech offers 35 undergraduate and graduate degree programs that are STEM-designated by the Department of Homeland Security, enabling international graduates to qualify for extended work experience in the United States after graduation, through Optional Practical Training (OPT). Students may also work as interns in the United States related to their academic program as part of Curricular Practical Training (CPT).

## QUALIFY FOR INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

You may qualify for scholarships each academic year: up to \$25,000 for undergraduate students and \$3,000 for graduate students. There are a limited number of graduate assistantships available.

# HOW TO APPLY

## UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

1. Complete an online application at [nyit.edu/apply](https://nyit.edu/apply) or complete the Common Application at [commonapp.org](https://commonapp.org). There is a \$50 nonrefundable application fee.
2. Submit required application materials:

### First-Year Students

- Copies of transcripts of all high school work, including college-level courses, translated into English.
- SAT or ACT scores are not required for admission or scholarships for international students. Review our test-optional policy: [nyit.edu/testoptional](https://nyit.edu/testoptional).

### Transfer Students

- Copies of transcripts of all college coursework.
- Credential evaluations by a National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) member organization, such as WES or GLOBE for foreign college credentials.
- If you have fewer than 24 college credits, you must also submit official high school transcripts.

3. Submit proof of English proficiency (TOEFL/IELTS/PTE/Duolingo).
4. Submit two letters of recommendation.
5. Complete your 300- to 350-word essay on one of the following topics:
  - Tell us about your career goals and why attending New York Tech would further these goals.
  - Describe the achievement of which you are most proud and why.
  - If you are applying to the nursing program, explain your desire to work in the nursing field.

## GRADUATE STUDENTS

1. Complete an online application at [nyit.edu/apply](https://nyit.edu/apply). There is a \$50 nonrefundable application fee.
2. Submit required application materials:
  - Copies of undergraduate transcripts and mark sheets for all schools attended.
  - Copy of college diploma or proof of degree.
  - Official GRE, GMAT, or MAT scores, if applicable to program requirements.
3. Submit proof of English proficiency (TOEFL/IELTS/PTE/Duolingo).

Some programs may require additional application materials, such as a portfolio or course-by-course evaluation. Check program requirements online.

## ENGLISH AND I-20 REQUIREMENTS

- TOEFL IBT score of 79, IELTS score of 6.0, Pearson PTE score of 53 or higher, or Duolingo English Test score of 105. You may be admitted to the Pathway Program with a TOEFL IBT score between 41 and 78, IELTS score between 5.0 and 5.5, Pearson PTE score between 36 and 52, or Duolingo English Test score of 70.
- Notarized Affidavit of Support and bank statement from your bank or your sponsor's bank to demonstrate financial support. You must have minimum liquid assets of:
  - \$55,000 if applying as an undergraduate student.
  - \$42,000 if applying as a graduate student.
  - \$35,000 if you are admitted to a Pathway Program.
  - \$28,000 if applying to the English as a Second Language (ESL) program.
