Stony Brook is a highly selective institution, seeking to enroll those students demonstrating the intellectual curiosity and academic ability to succeed. Freshman admission is based primarily on the strength and breadth of the student's academic preparatory program, grade point average and English proficiency scores. Other criteria include a letter of recommendation and an essay.

Stony Brook University offers up to 50% tuition with the #YouAreWelcomeHere scholarships. Other scholarships are offered with admission to Honors College, WISE or University scholars programs. Additionally, need-based money for scholarships is available.

Apply as early as possible and submit all supporting documentation in consideration of the visa application process.
