Students who have graduated from a secondary school and who have also earned at least 12 semester credit hours of college-level coursework at a **post-secondary institution** should apply as transfer students.

#### **British Ordinary Level English Language Exam (GCE/GCSE/IGCSE)**

**Grade of A or B in First-Language English** 

Submit original or certified true copy of certificate

#### **Transfer Credit as proof of English proficiency**

**24 or more transferable credits** from an accredited two- or four-year post-secondary institution in the U.S. at the time of application with a **GPA of 3.0 or better**, including **6 credits of non-remedial**, non-ESL coursework in English composition and/or speech communication with a grade of B or better.

Exceptional SAT or ACT may be considered as a proof of English proficiency.
