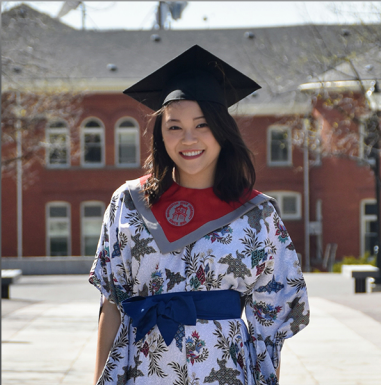


INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXPERIENCES
